



## Rebates & Incentives

### COOLING TOWERS QUALIFICATIONS/GUIDELINES

All projects shall comply with the General Qualifications/Guidelines to qualify for a rebate. Please refer to the General Qualifications/Guidelines document for further details.

1. The code baseline for qualifying equipment is listed below in Table 1.
2. The rebate application must be accompanied by the manufacturer's rating information based on Cooling Technology Institute (CTI) Standards and warranty information. Refer to CTI ATC-105 and STD-201.
3. Rebates are based on \$300/kW, direct kW reduced (estimate).

Centrifugal Fan Closed-Circuit Cooling Towers	All	102°F Entering Water 90°F Leaving Water 75°F Entering wb	≥7.0 gpm/hp	CTI ATC-105 and CTI STD-201

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
